What is Connecting Learners?

Connecting Learners is a life long learning project.

It is a partnership between UNISON, the public service union and its host organisation, Community Lives Consortium.

The aim of the project is to widen participation in learning, focusing on the non-traditional, hard to reach learner. In other words, those with little or no qualifications, those with negative experiences of main stream school and those employed in the lower paid bands with little access to training

Who is eligible?

We will focus on (but are not exclusive to): Paid staff and volunteers working in the following areas:

- NHS Health Boards
- Local Authority Social Care Providers
- Care Providers in the Third, Private and Independent Care Sectors
- School Support Staff

What Will Connecting Learners Provide?

- Free organisational and individual **training needs analysis**
- **Fully funded workshops** and training activities.
- **Contextualised , sector specific-workshops** to meet the needs of your staff and organisation
- Support to access further funding through the Welsh Government's **Essential Skills in the Workplace** programme
- Sustainability of activities via our new Train the Trainer programme
- Informal advice and guidance or formal one-to-one Coaching
- Recruitment, training and on-going support for Union Learning Representatives (ULRs) to sustain a workplace learning culture
- Opportunities to participate in national learning festivals, eg: Adult Learners Week, Six Book Challenge
